

Pursuant to Article 145 paragraph 1 of the Law on air Traffic Aviation (Official Gazette of Montenegro, number 30/12), Civil Aviation Agency of Montenegro has determined as follows - passengers are not permitted to carry the following articles in their hold baggage:

Explosives and incendiary substances and devices – explosives and incendiary substances and devices capable of being used to cause serious injury or to pose a threat to the safety of aircraft, including:

- ammunition,
- blasting caps
- detonators and fuses
- mines, grenades and other explosive military stores,
- fireworks and other pyrotechnics,
- smoke-generating canisters and smoke-generating cartridges,
- dynamite, gunpowder and plastic explosives.

Please note:

- The appropriate authority may prohibit articles in addition to those mentioned above.
- Security staff may refuse the transportation of hold baggage containing an article not covered in the list above over which they have concern.
